PACE OF PLAY RECOMMENDATIONS

BEFORE PLAY:

- Arrive early and check in with Starter
- Allow time to use the driving range and putting green
- Partner up and get equipment into a shared cart
- Be ready to proceed to the tee when called
- Know the basic rules of golf and golf etiquette

ON THE TEES AND FAIRWAYS:

- Play "Ready" golf go directly to your ball and hit as long as no one is in your way or you put someone in danger
- Cart Driver go directly to your passenger's ball and drop them off and immediately proceed to your own ball. Hit your ball and return to pick up passenger
- Cart Driver park the cart halfway between your and passenger's tee shot and both golfers walk to their ball and play second shot. Continue this until ball is on or around green
- Take three or so clubs to ball when walking from cart. This will allow you options in case you miscalculated yardage, wind or lie
- Minimize practice swings and waggles
- Hit a provisional ball if you think your ball is lost or out of bounds. Limit search for ball to two minutes if possible

ON THE GREENS:

- Putt away if you are ready to putt and won't step onto someone's line
- Continuous putting once you start putting, continue until ball is holed only if you can do it without stepping onto someone's line of play
- Line up your putt while others are putting
- Mark your ball only if it is dirty and you want to clean it or it is in the way of another ball
- Park the cart on cart path on the way to the next tee box
- Proceed to next tee immediately after putting out. Write scores down on next t-box

REMEMBER - PACE OF PLAY IS MEASURED BY HOW WELL YOU ARE KEEPING UP WITH THE GROUP IN FRONT OF YOU!
