NEW BUSINESS

- **Safety reminder for the 18th hole.** The creek is extremely dangerous. Please use good judgement when going after a ball lost in the creek and rocks. Balls can be easily replaced.
- **Ready golf** - If you have a lost ball follow the 3-minute rule, then take the penalty and move on. Watch your playing partners when at all possible to reduce "hunting" time.

- **12-4 Rule** - Take no more than a score of 12 with 4 putts.
- **Sand trap rule** - In the trap you are allowed to move the ball away from the trap with a 2-stroke penalty. Drop no closer to the hole. Can go back or sideways.
- **Out of Bounds Rule** - If a player hits out-of-bounds, bring the ball straight out to the fairway. Lay out 2 club lengths and drop your ball for play or go back to the tee to hit again. 2 stroke penalty is to be taken. Question: Does it apply to part 3's where taking the penalty could actually put you on the green?
- *Post note added by Susan Sagahon - Here is a description of the rule: "A new local rule was introduced with the newest edition of the Rules of Golf when they were released in 2019. The new stroke-and-distance local rule allows players the option of dropping in the fairway if they so choose. Players must find where their ball went out of bounds and create an imaginary perpendicular to the fairway, no closer to the hole. From there, you can now drop anywhere within two club-lengths behind the line. The next shot will be your fourth. This rule keeps groups moving and speeds up play."*
- **Prize money** - This money goes into a player's account with Golf Ops and will show on the player's receipt. There is a line on the receipt for tournament sweeps. Also, there's a line for member credit on the receipt. Use these for beer, play, shopping.

 - Declare your tee to use always (Green, Red or Combo). Once declared, please do not change for the rest of the season.
 - If you have been playing from the red tees, and your handicap is consistently over 24, please consider switching to the Green tees. This will help with speed of play and no doubt make your game more enjoyable. Remember, the goal of the game is to at least achieve par!
- Members have until Monday to submit their name for play the following week.
- On Tuesday Mary is required to submit the final schedule

- Cost \$2.00 weekly is to be paid to Mary for her work as the monitor. Members can write a check for \$10.00 or \$20.00 to advance pay. Make check payable to *Mary Monfre*. She will be maintaining a spread sheet.
